

## Vegetable Planting Dates for North Texas

### FALL Harvest

(by Seed = direct seed outdoors)

#### May 5 – May 31:

Tomatoes by seed (mid-May is ideal)  
Plant outside mid July.

#### June 15 – July 25

Eggplant by seed or transplants  
Hot Pepper transplants  
Sweet Bell Pepper transplants  
Tomato transplants  
Cantaloupe, Watermelon by seed

**July 1 – August 1:** Southern Peas by seed

**July 1 – August 10:** Winter Squash by seed

#### July 15 – August 15:

Okra by seed or transplant  
Small Pumpkin by seed

#### July 25 – August 10:

Seed potatoes

#### August 1 – August 15:

Snap Pole Beans by seed  
Broccoli by seed  
Brussels Sprouts by seed  
Cabbage by seed  
Cauliflower by seed  
Sweet Corn by seed  
Pickling Cucumber by seed  
Slicing Cucumber by seed

#### August 1 – August 25:

Kohlrabi by seed  
Summer Squash by seed  
Pan-type Summer Squash by seed  
Zucchini Squash by seed

#### August 1 – September 1:

Snap Bush Beans by seed  
Yellow Bush Beans by seed  
Pinto Beans by seed  
Swiss Chard by seed or transplant  
Collard Greens by seed or transplant

#### August 1 – September 10:

Mustard Greens by seed or transplant

#### August 1 – October 1:

Parsley by seed or transplant

#### August 1 – October 15:

Rutabaga by seed  
Spinach by seed or transplant

#### August 10 – September 1:

Chinese Cabbage by seed or transplant

#### August 15 – September 1:

Head type Lettuce by seed

#### August 15 – September 5:

Carrots by seed

#### August 15 – September 10:

Butterhead Lettuce by seed

#### August 15 – September 15:

Leaf Lettuce by seed  
Romaine or Cos Lettuce by seed

#### August 15 – October 31:

Broccoli transplants  
Brussels Sprouts transplants  
Cabbage transplants  
Cauliflower transplants

#### August 25 – October 1:

Collard Greens by seed  
Kale by seed

#### August 25 – October 15:

Turnips by seed

#### September 1 – September 15:

Beets by seed

#### September 1 – October 1:

English/ French Peas by seed

#### September 10 – October 1:

Leeks by seed or transplant  
Onion by seed  
Garlic
